Term of Position

The At-Large International Representative's term on the Executive Board of Directors is three years **(2023 -2025)**.

Position Description

The At-Large International Representative is **appointed** to the Executive Board of Directors by the Board. All voting ATSA members who do not reside in the United States are eligible to have their names put forward for nomination.

The At-Large International Representative serves as the Chair of the International Committee and oversees ATSA's strategic goals and objectives related to broadening ATSA's knowledge and perspective on world issues and increased international collaboration.

The At-Large International Representative:

- Adheres to the Executive Board of Director's job description and ATSA's Code of Ethics,
- Provides direct communication to international members to better fulfill their membership needs;
- Informs the Executive Board of Directors of current trends related to prevention, practice, and policy from an international perspective;
- Liaises with international members to inform them of current trends related to prevention, practice, and policy in the United States;
- Fosters opportunities to collaborate on joint projects and initiatives with international stakeholders;
- Works with other ATSA committees such as Public Policy, Membership, Adult Practice, and Child and Adolescent Practice committees;
- Assists with increasing the overall visibility and profile of ATSA to expand the organization's reach to a broad range of stakeholders;
- Manages a budget related to committee activities.
